CHRISTMAS WREATH



This card is a little more elaborate. But you don't have to be an artist to create it, because it's just drawn with simple shapes.

MATERIALS White and red card stock Black pen, e.g. fineliner Green and red pens, e.g. felt-tip pens, crayons Scissors Glue stick

- 1 Start by cutting out the card to the desired size. The standard format for a greeting card is A6, which is 10.5 x 14.8 cm. You can either measure it out or cut round another greeting card as a template. Cut out the white card stock a little bit smaller than the red, so that you get a red frame once they are glued together.
- 2 Put the red card aside for the time being. Draw a circle on the white card with a pencil. The circle can almost completely fill the card, but you need to leave a little space to draw in the wreath. The next step is to draw leaves with a green pen and berries with a red pen. It's best to draw very simple shapes such as teardrop shapes or circles. If you are unsure, you can draw the shapes in pencil first. Add details with a black fineliner at the end.
- **3** Finally, glue the white card onto the middle of the red card. If you like, you can cut out the middle of the wreath before you stick it on. Write a Christmas greeting inside the wreath.
